Day 2

Read Genesis 1–2:3

Grab a sheet of paper and fold it in half lengthwise, then in half two times crosswise. Open the paper up and in the first section, write “The Creation Story.” Then, write Day 1 on the top of the next square and so on until you’ve labeled the remaining boxes through Day 7.

As you read Genesis 1–2:3, draw what you’re reading in each of the sections. They can be super simple drawings, more detailed, or even just colors in the block that make you think of that aspect of creation.

Hang your artwork somewhere you will see it the rest of the week.

Day 3

Look back at your artwork from yesterday—specifically at day 6, the day God created humans.

When God created humans, it was the beginning of something amazing—something that eventually led to you! And because God created you, you can be creative!

Read this prayer out loud, thanking God for creating you to be creative.

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**Dear God,** thank You for making me—and for making me in Your image. I know that means that I am creative because You are creative! Please show me all the unique ways You made me to be creative and help me to use that creativity to show the world who You are. In Jesus’ Name, I pray. **Amen.**

## Day 4

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### How are you creative?

There are so many different ways to be creative, and sometimes we don’t even realize what we’re doing is creative and God-given!

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Take a poll! Ask friends and family to brainstorm ways people can be creative.

Start out your list with the following obvious choices:

- ▶ Painter
- ▶ Writer
- ▶ Musician
- ▶ Actor
- ▶ Dancer

Each person should give you a new idea. If they mention something you already have on your list, ask them to try again. See how many creative ways you can come up with to be . . . creative. Hold on to your list for tomorrow.

Day 5
